The Panel's recommendations represent no change from the revised 2013/14 Scheme, except as follows:-

- Motor Cycles – All engine size paid at HMRC rate for business mileage (index linked from 1 April 2014 to 31 March 2017 (up to 10,000 miles 24.0p
- increase in the maximum weekly payment for Dependants' Carers and Childcare Allowance to £107.20
